We'll start the trip in Phnom Penh, the capital of Cambodia! You'll start your trip with a day of cultural orientation where you will visit some historical sites, and you'll get to stop by the RAW Office to meet our team! You'll then spend the next few days getting on the tools in the community development program at our Every Piece Matters (EPM) Village.

After your time in Phnom Penh, you'll travel up to Kratie province. We'll be working on the amazing Trong Island where RAW is building a 'home base' for our future work in Ko Ki Village. One day all our teams are going to stay here as well as our regional manager and support crew/equipment. Get ready for an unforgettable, bicycle-only local village experience like no other!!

At the end of your trip, you'll get to explore Siem Reap and enjoy some rest and relaxation. You'll visit the world-famous Angkor Wat temples, explore the Night Markets and enjoy a team dinner on your final night before departing.









## YOUR ITINERARY

1 - 11 July 2026

#### Day 1

Arrive Phnom Penh, scenic tuk tuk ride to the Onra hotel. First team dinner and get to know the RAW Crew.

#### Day 2

Cultural orientation with a visit to the RAW office, Genocide Museum, and Killing Fields.

#### Day 3

Breakfast at the hotel and morning meeting. Project day at EPM Bamboo Village.

### Day 4

Projects continue, students now confident on the tools and getting a roll on.

### Day 5

The final push, and handover with the EPM families. Last dinner together in Phnom Penh.

#### Day 6

Travel to Kratie province and settle into accomodation at the Mekong Dolphin hotel.

#### Day 7

Breakfast at local cafe, travel to Trong Island on the ferry, pushbike to our project site.

#### Day 8

Final day on the tools at Trong Island, team trip debrief and dinner at local restaurant.

#### Day 9

Travel to Siem Reap and settle into accomodation at Amber Angkor hotel

#### **Day 10**

Temples day! Sunrise at Angkor Wat, breakfast at hotel then visit more temples. Final team dinner, night markets.

#### **Day 11**

Morning farewell RAW Crew and fly home from Siem Reap.
