## YOUR TEAM'S IMPACT



\$1,600

Can provide one household in Nepal with a water tank for harvesting rainwater, so that they don't have to walk long distances for water that is still often unsafe.



\$2,500

Can establish a revolving fund to provide start-up capital for 10 forums for adolescent girls and young women in Zimbabwe.



\$3,400

Can provide a food bank for people living in remote Bangladesh to maintain their food supply during floods and other natural disasters.



\$5,000

Can provide agriculture entrepreneurship training for 20 women in Pakistan, so they can gain marketing and packaging skills, and also learn how to calculate input cost and output cost.



\$7,500

Can install a toilet block in a school in Nepal, with sanitary waste disposal facilities in the female toilets so girls can stop missing a week of school each month, and start enjoying equal education.



\$10,000

Can provide a solar-powered peanut butter machine to a community in Malawi, to empower people to earn a sustainable living and increase food security and nutrition.
